





Presentation on Watershed Development and Road Water Harvesting Activities in SNNPR Feb 27, 2017; Mekelle, Ethiopia

Background Information

- ❖ Area: 110,931 sq. km
- Population: Around 19 million (Projected based on 2007 census)
 - ☐ More than 56 ethnic groups
 - ☐ Urban population: 7.5%
- ❖ Annual Ave. Temperature: 7.5-27.5 Dc
- Annual Ave. Rainfall: 400-2200mm

Watershed Development Activities (2016/17 FY)

- Regional Mass mobilization: Started as of *February* 10, 2017 (For Twenty days)
 - □ No. of People participating: M = 3,030,089; F = 2,449,279(44.7%); Total = 5,479,368
- Main Activities:
 - ☐ No of sub-basins to be developed : 3760
 - Terracing: 415,000 km
 - ☐ Flood diversion works: 40,000 km
 - ☐ Trench excavation works: 1,420,000 m3
 - ☐ Area Closure: 440,500 ha
 - ☐ Seedlings plantation: 1.2 billion

Road & its catchment Water Harvesting

- Started in 2016/2017 FY with collaboration of BoANRD & SRA
 - ☐ Finance & technical support from GIZ

Main Activities:

- ➤ 18 Ponds excavation with (5000 cubic meter): by machinery (SRA)
- > Cattle troughs construction: by Wereda admin.
- Compaction and fencing: by the community (labor & material)
- Used mainly for Cattle drink and small irrigation
- Intended to reduce flooding

Plans & Trends on Road Construction (SRA)

- Design of roads as per ERA manual
- ☐ Construct and maintain roads.
 - ➤ In 2016/17 FY, the plan for DS6 roads const:1410 Km and URRAP: 3052km (Total 4462km)
 - cross culvert/bridges are constructed, but no due consideration (during design) for RWH.



Issues to be addressed

- Design Consideration: RWH should be taken into consideration during road design
- Integration: The regional BoANRD, BoEPFD and RAs should integrate their plan for RWH, roadside tree planting & Watershed management
- Scaling up: The experience and techniques developed in Tigray region & Mekelle university should be scaled up to other regions and universities (HU, AMU)
- *Research based technical support & capacity building: Like MetaMeta and others
