

1. Introduction of Kitui County

- Arid and semi-arid region with erratic and unreliable rainfall
- The county is faced with cyclical hydrological and agricultural drought, hence food and water insecure
- The increasing population projected at 2.1% p.a implies increased demand for the multiple uses of the available water resources
- The limited water resources invoke a programmatic approach to address the challenge

2. County Programs


- Integration of Roads for Water Program with other county programs
- Training of County staff in the selected sub-counties (Kitui Rural and Kitui Central)
- Sensitization of farmers on the opportunities in roads for Water

2. County Programs

Roads

- > 2016/17 FY: Grading of 3000 km of roads;1250 km already done (county has 8 graders operating in different areas of the expansive county.
- > 132 road-drifts being constructed; most complete.
- Water
 - > 2400 Sand Dams to be constructed in the County
- Agriculture
 - On-farm ponds as means of enhancing small scale irrigation
